

iAM Video Project Requirements

Due Date: September 21 (projects will be presented/shared in class)

Who are you? For this project, you will have the opportunity to create a video project with Adobe Spark to tell the world who you are.

The requirements for your video are as follows:

A.) Address the following questions: What do you care about? Who do you care about? What/who do love/like/dislike? What do you aspire to be? You can incorporate anything else you feel is important.

B.) Include at least 20 images to help illustrate your video. You are encouraged to take your own photos outside of class on your phone or other device and upload them to your video project. Clip art, sounds, or images can be used to support your slides along with the digital photos. You can save photos to a flash drive, Google Photos, or even email them to your school account so that they are available to upload to your project at school.

C.) Include captions that explain the relevance of each image or group of 2-3 images in your video. For example, you might have a sentence or two that introduces an idea, followed by 3 images that illustrate the idea. You may also add voice recording if you choose.

D.) Begin with a title slide, displaying the title iAM, and a descriptor (an athlete, a dreamer, etc.), do not include your name on the first slide.

E.) Your final slide should say "I AM (your name)."

F.) Your presentation should be approximately 2-3 minutes long.
